Harlestone villa site – fieldwalked last year, now geophysics done – site probably 10 hectares. Report due.

Gayton – Blisworth society. 3 sites. One now cleaned and ready for processing. Easton Neston – Towcester group may take the lead on this next year with support from CLASP.

PAST have requested support with work on the new road between Harpole and Northampton.

Northants Archaeology keen to work with CLASP and have a community archaeology rep. Steve spoke at the Archaeology for All conference at Manchester where a group from CLASP ran a stall and were able to advise a local group.

7. Training

Need to decide overall strategy. Courses in CLASP's name will be taken as representing the organisation. May be an opportunity in the New Year to act as 'guinea pigs' for distance learning courses for Northampton University. Ideas include 'cascade' training (students train others), inviting in local experts, or getting someone else to organise training. Accreditation will be important but people will want to retain the 'fun' element.
