Matters Arising:-

Fees:- Tony Kesten is presently conducting a consultation exercise regarding the putting up of fees and will report back when this is complete. The Organising committee are doing a similar exercise. We will then call an EGM probably in about 6 months time.

Boddington Project:- DH reported that we had been asked to assist in the exploration of the cemetery which is close to Roman Remains, however he had politely declined because they thought they needed the work done at once. However, it now seems it does not need to be done until August 2012, therefore we could possibly help. SY and DH will look into the possibility of a magnetometer survey and possibly trial trenches.

GPR Training:- SY is re-booking dates, we will need to put the trainer up in a B&B, funds to come from the RRT cash. He reported that we also now have a resistivity meter. AE will look into the insurance position on this item. Only the magnetometer is named on our policy at present.

Whitehall Barn:- This property has now been sold subject to completion at the end of October. We have a possibly 2/3 months grace to remove our artefacts. DH had asked EH to put pressure on Weedon for an answer, but they refused, so no progress has been made in this area yet.

Barby Project:- Gren Hatton then presented his Barby project to us and reported on the work he had done in September, for our consideration. There is a link to his website via the CLASP site.
